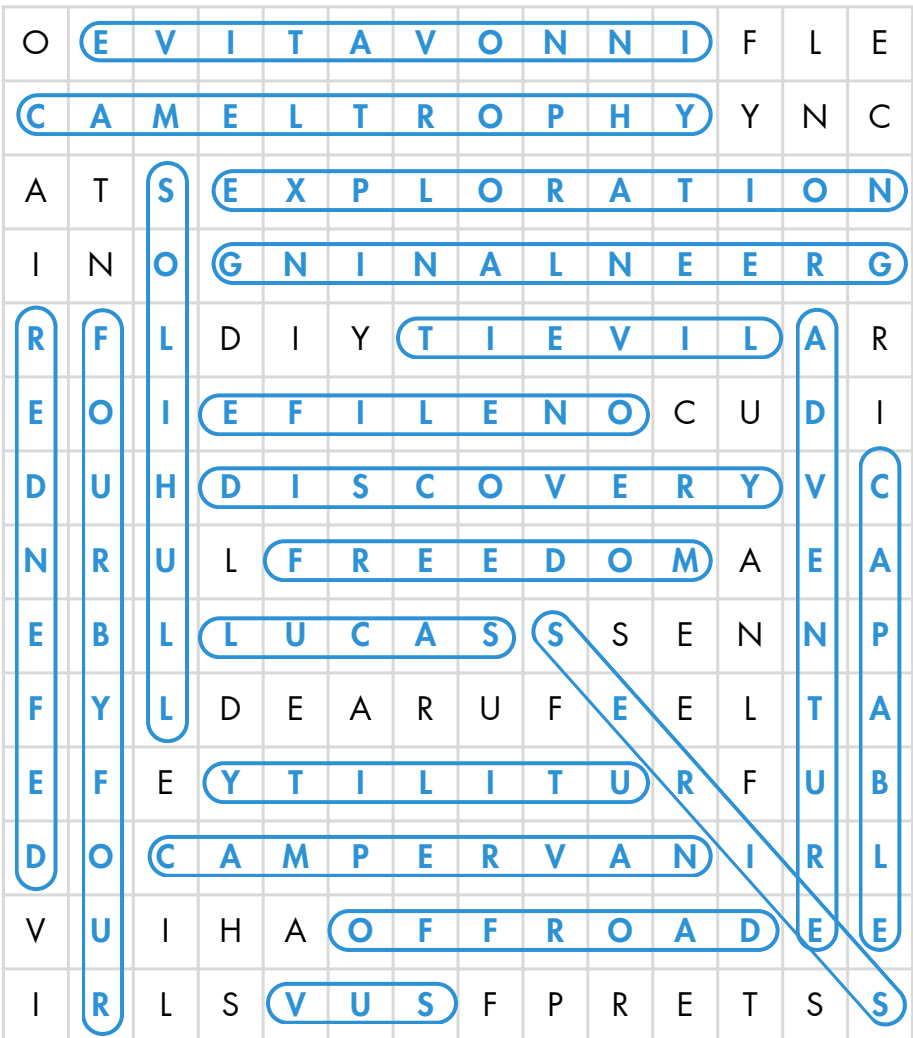

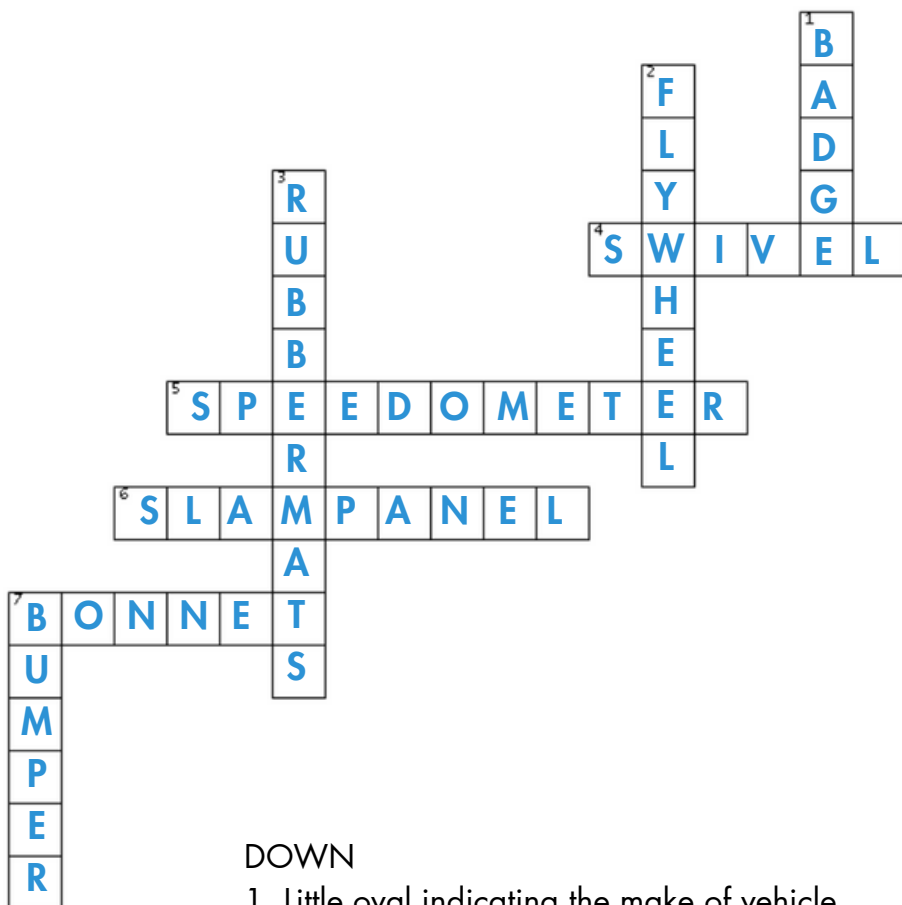

CROSSWORD PUZZLE



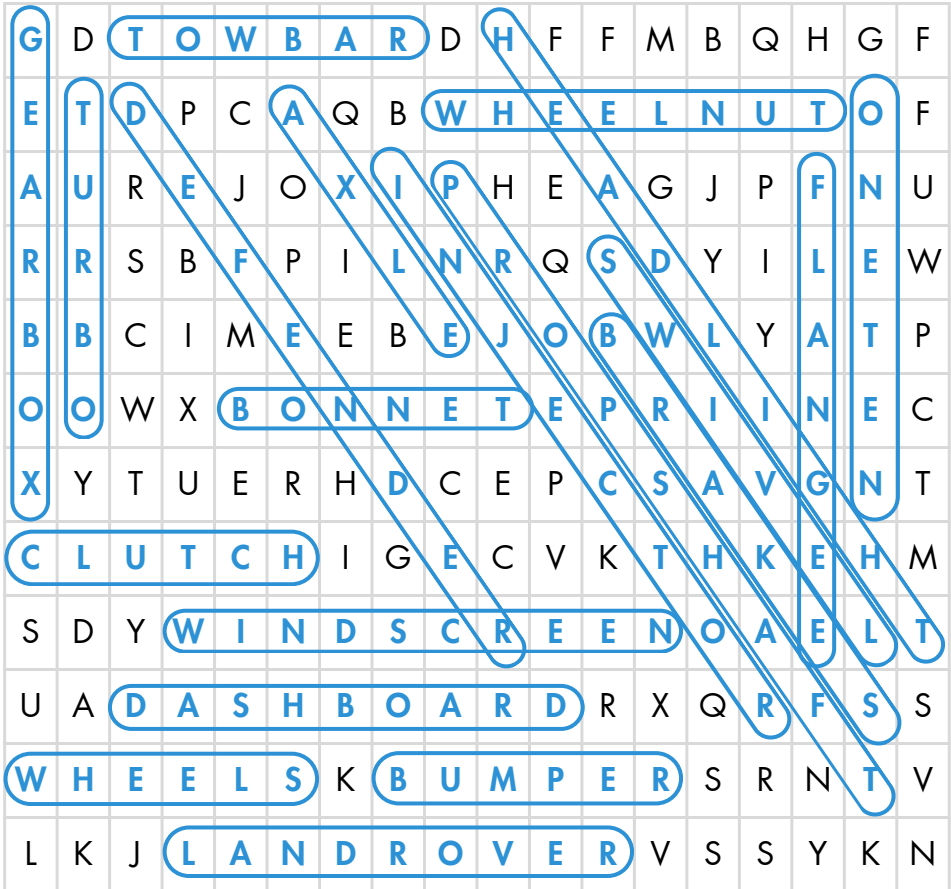
DOWN

1. Little oval indicating the make of vehicle
2. Big metal disc that the starter hooks into
3. Water catchments under your feet (2 words)
7. Most sticky-out bit in front and rear

ACROSS

4. Round part on front axle that makes the wheels turn left or right
5. Not strictly necessary, but indicates velocity
6. What the bonnet catch whacks into when dropped (2 words)
7. Covers the engine

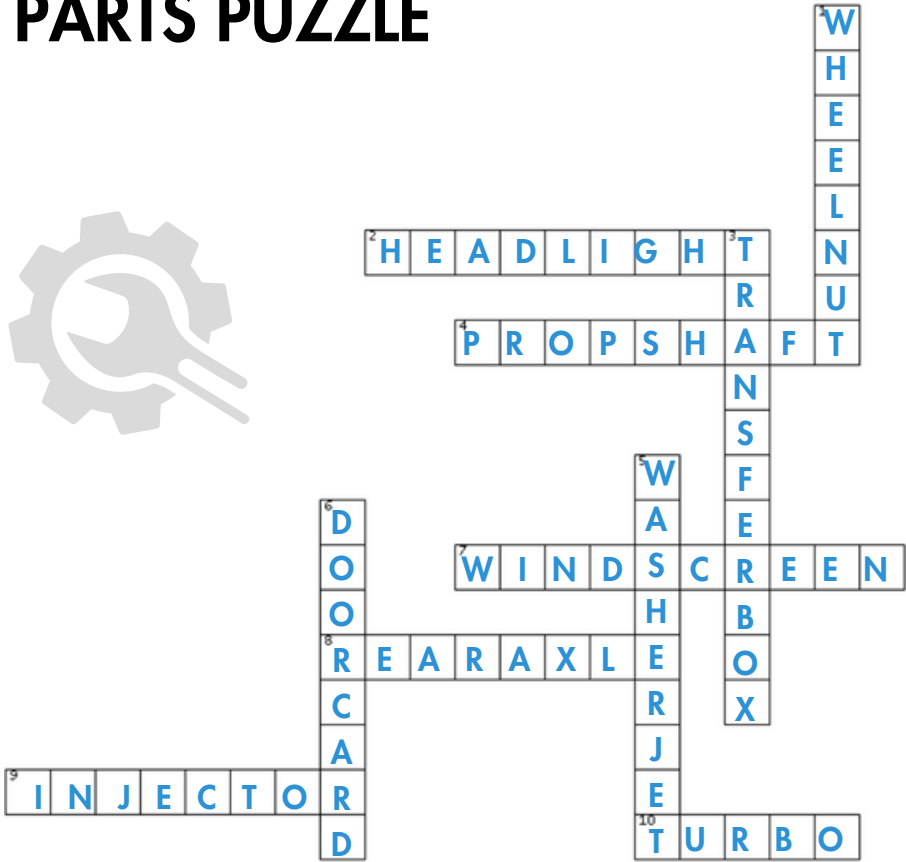

1. One of five that keeps the wheels on
3. Facilitates high and low range (2 words)
5. Squirts some soapy water (2 words)
6. Hides the inner workings of the door (2 words)

ACROSS

2. Helps to illuminate the road ahead at night
4. Sits between transfer box and diff
7. Keeps bugs out of your teeth, handy in the rain
8. What the rear wheels are attached to (2 words)
9. Measures the amount of diesel going in
10. Forces more air into the engine, for more noise

DOWN

1. Rotating shaft with cam lobes to move the valves
2. What you connect jumper leads to, when the car won't start
3. Semi-comfortable perches
4. Instrument showing a rough indication of how slow you're going
7. Also found between cylinder head and block
8. Keeps most of the engine oil in
10. Keeps alternator, water pump etc turning
12. Always needs topping up on steep hills
15. FM/AM, can't really hear it
17. Motto: Get Home Before Dark

ACROSS

5. Never sufficient to stop the car rolling away
6. Gives faint illumination of the road ahead
9. Back-or forward tilt of steering axis
11. Spins in the distributor
12. Clip that fits around shaft in a cylindrical groove
13. Usually what you're lying in when repairing the car
14. Pressurises intake air, driven by exhaust gas
16. Structure between engine and the car interior

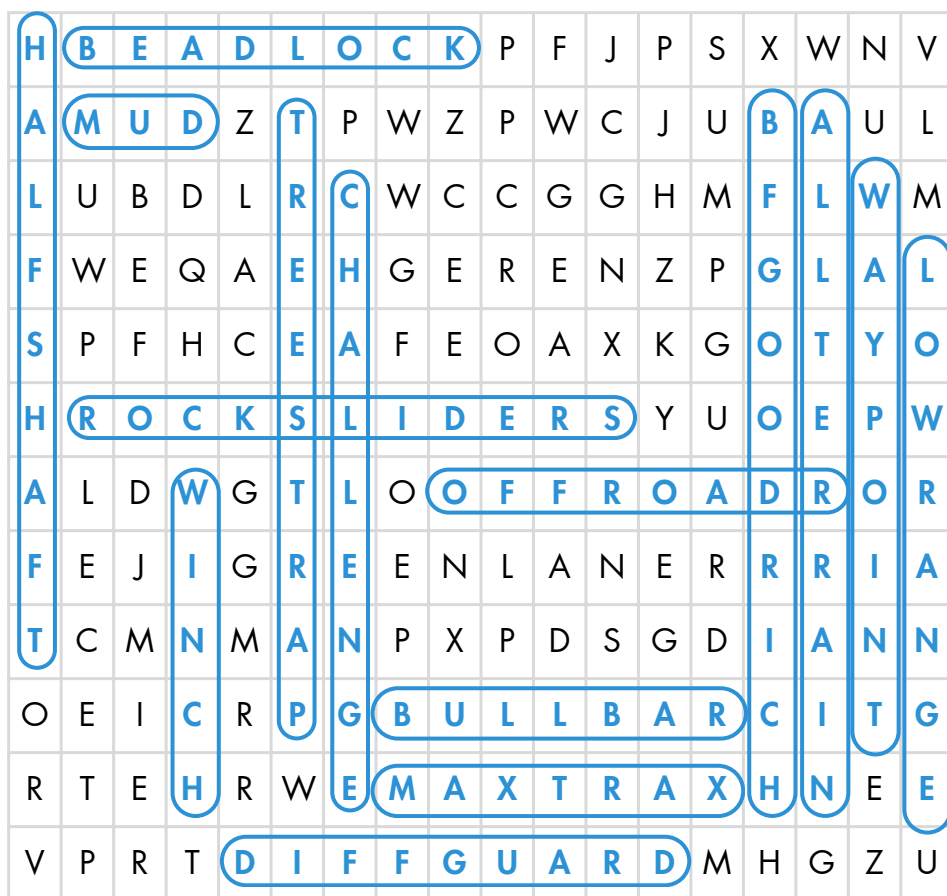

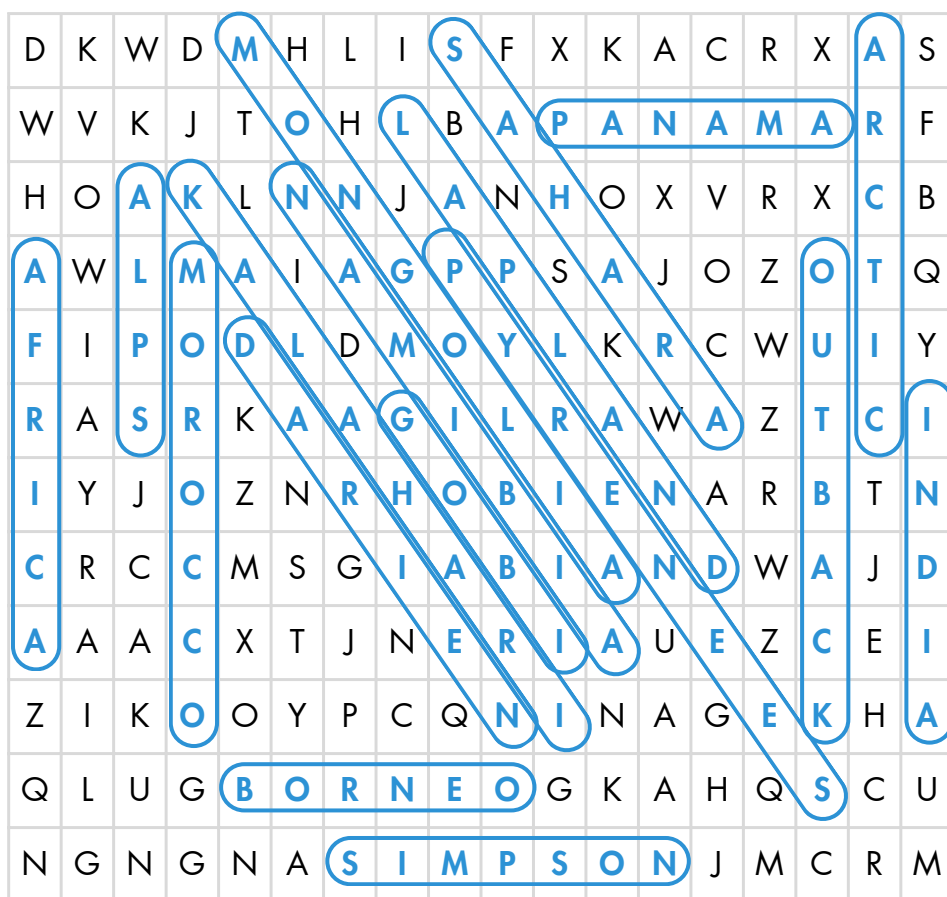

LANDY PARTS PUZZLE



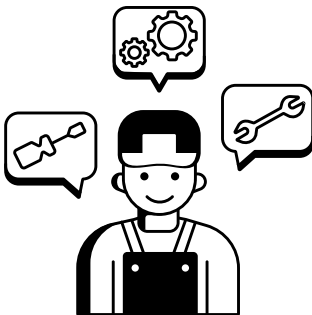
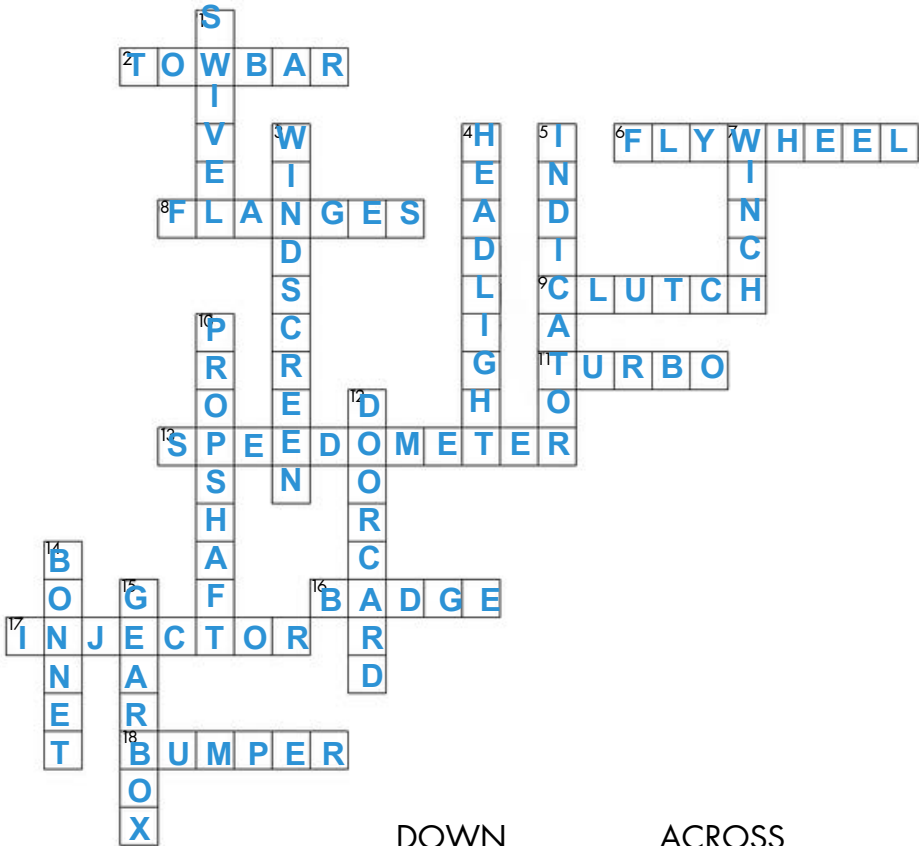
DOWN

1. In the axle, 1 per side, driven by the diff
2. Mixes fuel and air (mechanical, petrol)
3. 10 or 24, in the axle
4. Protects electrical circuit against overload
6. Follow too closely, BBQ in a parking lot
9. Often need replacing in the lighting circuit
10. Heat transfer device, keeps engine cool
12. Keeps alternator, water pump etc turning
13. Fluids normally found on the driveway
14. Rod connecting front axle to chassis
16. Lets air/fuel into cylinders and the exhaust gas out

ACROSS

1. Sometimes works to keep the interior warm
5. Cam follower
7. Never tells the right time
8. The wheel catching a free ride on the back door
11. Main engine shaft
15. Most dangerous jack ever made
17. Anti-friction device with inner and outer race
18. Needed when the bulkhead has rotted away
19. Belt-driven, charges the battery
